- You should NEVER write down or store the card security code, normally located on the back of a credit card. This code is also referred to as CVV (card verification value), CVN (card verification number), or CVC (card verification code).
- On MasterCard, Visa and Discover cards, the 3 digit card security code is located on the back of the card to the right of the signature box.
